For students attending non-scripture, these students are expected to continue to do independent classroom work, under the supervision of one of our teachers.

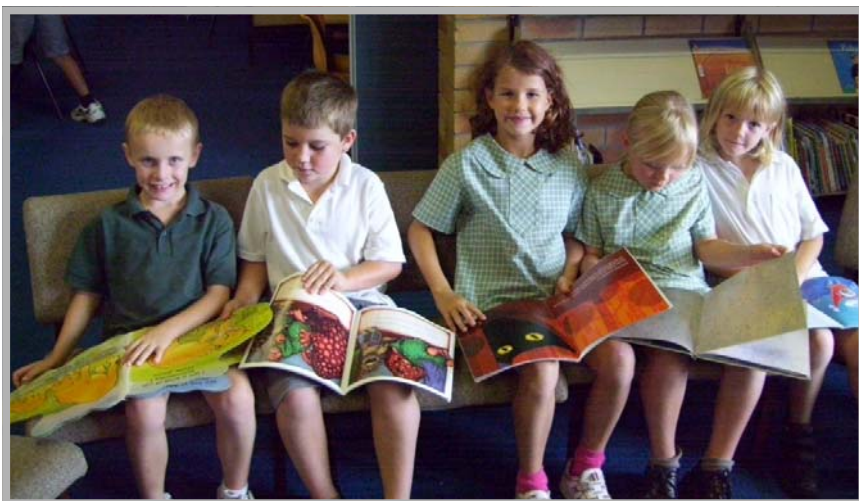
### Our students
