













(if this information is not included we have no way of identifying who made the payment)		FEES: With the maximum Child Care Benefit subsidy parents can pay as little as \$3.73 per child per day (plus excursions where applicable). Families who are eligible for the 50% tax rebate effectively pay as little as \$1.87 per child per day (plus excursions where applicable) once your rebate has been received. Standard Fees \$37 per day (plus excursion costs where applicable). FEES are payable at the beginning of care each week. Parents who have not linked their children for CCB will be requested to pay full fees until they are linked.
